In accordance with the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising:

- L'Arche Ireland has appointed a senior member of staff to be responsible for compliance with the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising.
- L'Arche Ireland ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising and its implementation.
- L'Arche Ireland has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising. Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the Director and the Board. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.
- L'Arche Ireland prepares [financial reports](#) consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
- L'Arche Ireland ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.
